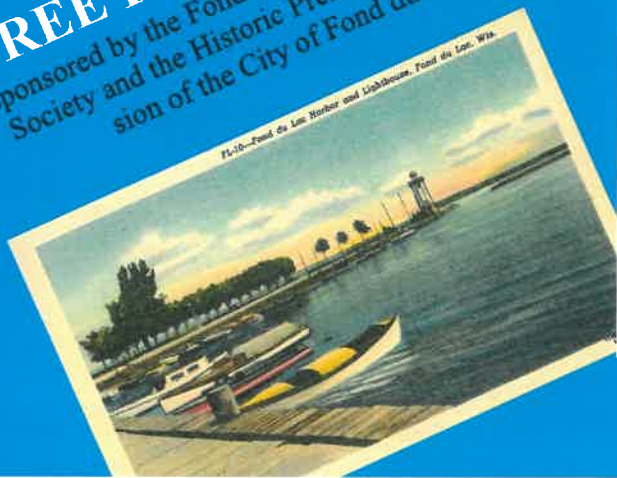

during the 1940s and the Smartphone Age

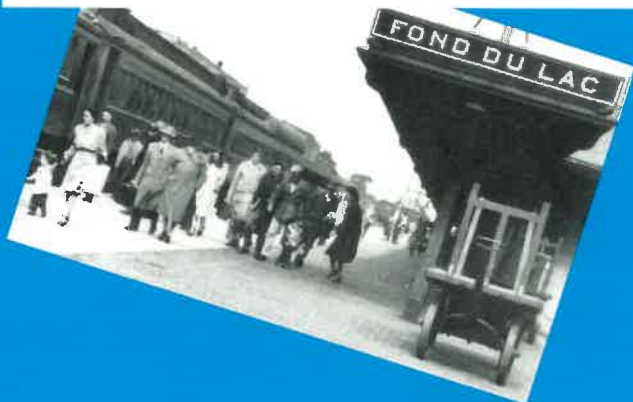
Annie's will have the popular drink of the
