Introduction Summary: This proposed Ordinance change would  
revise the current parking restrictions on South Peters Avenue  
near Evans School.

Subject: Remove existing parking restrictions "Parking, Standing, or Stopping Prohibited" in accordance with Code of Ordinances Section 630-8 and Section 630-41, Schedule "G", D. From 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 2:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m. on school days.

Location: Peters Avenue, South; West Side; from Bragg Street to 60 feet north.

Subject: Remove existing parking restriction "Parking Prohibited during Certain Periods" in accordance with Code of Ordinances Section 630-7 and Section 630-40, Schedule "F", F. From 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on school days.

Location: Peters Avenue; In front of Evans School.

at All Times" in accordance with Code of Ordinances Section 630-  
6 and Section 630-39, Schedule "E".

Location: Peters Avenue, North, Both Sides; Including areas  
along the median strip from West Johnson Street to West  
Scott Street.
