Based on true events, "Argo" chronicles the life-or-death covert operation to rescue six Americans that unfolded behind the scenes of the Iran hostage crisis -- the truth of which was unknown by the public for decades. On November 4, 1979, as the Iranian revolution reached its boiling point, militants stormed the U.S. embassy in Tehran, taking 52 Americans hostage.



But, in the midst of the chaos, six Americans managed to slip away and find refuge in the home of the Canadian ambassador. Knowing it was only a matter of time before the six were found out and likely killed, a CIA "exfiltration" specialist named Tony Mendez (Ben Affleck) came up with a risky plan to get them safely out of the country. This by-the-book action thriller hits all the right notes, with suspenseful just-in-the-nick-of-time escape scenes. "Argo" nabbed a Golden Globe for Best Film--Drama and best Director, and has been nominated for seven Academy Awards. **Director: Ben Affleck.
