## MAY BIKE RIDE

On **Wednesday, May 8, at 10:00 a.m.**, meet at the fairgrounds swimming pool parking lot on Martin Road. From there, riders will bike Martin Road to the 151 Bike Trail to **Peebles** stop/go lights and back to the fairgrounds. This ride will be on paved trails and be about 10 to 12 miles.

## JUNE BIKE RIDE

Join us on **Wednesday, June 12, at 10:00 a.m.** in the Target parking lot to ride along the Eldorado Marsh to **Rosendale or Eldorado** (depending on trail conditions). Bring money for lunch in Eldorado. Also, bring along a water bottle to stay hydrated. This trip is about 10-12 miles.

## JULY BIKE RIDE

On **Wednesday, July 10**, meet at **10:00 a.m.**, at the Rolling Meadows rest stop. If you drive there, parking is available. The meeting place is about ¼ mile south of Rolling Meadows Golf Course on Rolling Meadows Drive. We will ride along the **Wild Goose Trail to Oakfield**. Bring along money for lunch at Oak Central. This trip is about 10-15 miles. This is not a paved trail.

## AUGUST BIKE RIDE

On **Wednesday, August 14**, at **10:00 a.m.**, meet the gang at the Lake Denevue Shelter at Lakeside Park. From there, you'll ride to the **County Garage** and return along the east branch of the Fond du Lac river. The ride will be 8-10 miles and totally on pavement, no gravel trails or roads.

## SEPTEMBER BIKE RIDE

On **Wednesday, September 11**, at **10:00 a.m.**, meet at the DeNeveu Shelter in Lake Side Park. The ride will be 8-10 miles on a trail to **Taycheedah and Sandy Beach**. Lunch will be at A & W Drive In.

## OCTOBER BIKE RIDE

On **Wednesday, October 9**, at **10:00 a.m.** meet at the Rolling Meadows rest stop. If you drive there parking is available. The meeting place is about ¼ mile south of Rolling Meadows Golf Course on Rolling Meadows Drive. The ride will be 9-10 miles round-trip along Hickory Street Road to and from **Hobbs Woods**. The group will go on a short hike through Hobbs Woods and return back to Fond du Lac for lunch at Rolling Meadows Restaurant.
