**Public information meeting scheduled for**  
**North Rolling Meadows Drive and South Walmart Driveway**  
**CTH VVV**  
**Fond du Lac County**

**Proposed transportation improvement**

The City of Fond du Lac will host a public information meeting to present the preliminary engineering plan for improvements to North Rolling Meadows Drive (CTH VVV) in the City of Fond du Lac, Fond du Lac County. The project begins approximately 450' north of STH 23 and extends northerly for a distance of approximately 300' through the southern Walmart driveway.

The proposed project consists of adding a dedicated, slotted right turn lane along North Rolling Meadows Drive at the southern Walmart driveway location. The slotted right turn lane will be separated by curb and gutter and a concrete corrugated median. The slotted right turn lane will separate the traffic turning into the Walmart driveway and will provide additional visibility for vehicles exiting the Walmart driveway onto Rolling Meadows Drive.

Construction is currently scheduled for 2016. The northbound outside lane and southern Walmart driveway will be closed to traffic during construction.
