Course Overview

This course is designed to challenge the student and help them develop data they will need in future shooting environments. Students will face team challenges, obstacles, barriers, and re-enacted snipers shots. Every shot taken during this course is designed to enhance the data in you shooter log as well as the use of your gear. Non-shooting spotters are encouraged to attend and admitted for free.

Course Duration: Two Day - Different drills each day

Day One:

- Cold Shot, Cold Group
- Range estimation
- Glass Shots
- Timed shots
- "Best Buy" shot recreation
- Low light shoot
- Odd shooting positions

Day Two:

- Cold Shot, Cold Group
- Car Shoot
- Movement
- "Bank of America" shot recreation
- Odd Roof Shots
- "Best Hand" Shoot



| Prerequisites |

All students should be proficient in firearms skills. Students must pass a "minimum skills" assessment course on Monday in order to proceed with the rest of the week of instruction. This assessment is basic in nature but necessary to assure a minimum level of proficiency & increase safety in a live fire environment.

Each attendee must be physically fit for duty and able to perform the physical skills associated with tactical applications with the use of these products. The Safariland Training Group trains only sworn law-enforcement officers, correctional personnel, state-licensed security personnel (OC only) or active military personnel.

- Eye Protection
- Ear Protection
- Duty Belt and related gear
- Shooter's Log
- Rifle
- 250 rounds of duty ammunition
- 20 rounds of barrier penetrating ammunition (optional)

Students should be physically prepared for these classes in order to ensure successful completion of the courses. Some of these courses involve exposure to chemical agents as well as the physical exercises.
