



Re: Police Department Command Structure
Reorganization



I intend to reorganize the police department's command structure. As a result I need your approval to eliminate the deputy chief's position and to authorize the creation of two assistant chief positions.

On December 3, 2012, Deputy Chief Kevin Lemke officially announced that he would be retiring effective January 16, 2013. We have been discussing the need to change our command structure from its existing state for more than a year and we believe that now would be the time to make those changes. Based on the considerations discussed in this memo I ask the Council to approve creation of two Assistant Chief Positions within the Fond du Lac Police Department as part of a command structure reorganization.

The department has experimented with several different command structure models over the course of the past several years and it is a very widely held belief that the current structure that is in existence has a number of limitations. More specifically, the structure does not include a position that is dedicated, almost exclusively, to provide operational command/oversight. This has caused the department to experience limitations in this area.

The model that we are proposing is essentially a return to one that the department had most recently used prior to moving to the existing model (approximately four years ago). Under the existing structure, the second-in-command position for the department is held by one person (Deputy Chief of Police). As such, the Deputy Chief has oversight responsibility for both administrative and operational matters within the department.

We are proposing a return to a structure where the second-in-command level of the department is split between operations and administration (Assistant Chief – Operations and Assistant Chief – Administration). This move would increase our efficiencies, accountability, and effectiveness by better enabling each of the Assistant Chiefs to more specifically focus on their respective area of departmental responsibility. As it relates to the overall level of responsibility for command, control, and oversight of departmental operations and administration, the duties and responsibilities would, essentially, be the same as the existing Deputy Chief's position. However, the span of control would be narrowed so each could primarily focus on their assigned area (operations or administration).

Again, this is a model that the department used as recently as four years ago and, by all accounts, provided the department with greater efficiencies. It should be noted that it is also more similar in nature to the structure that is used by our Fire Department as well as the Police Departments in many comparable cities throughout the state of Wisconsin.

I have discussed this proposal with City Manager Joe Moore and our Human Resources Department. Authorization has been provided at that level to proceed with this command structure reorganization if the budget impact is neutral or provides a reduction. It is believed that a combination of reduced salary level for the second in command positions (due to the reduced span of control), the elimination of an administrative captain's position, and a lag in filling affected positions will make this budget neutral. As of the preparation of this memo we are actively working with both the City's Department of Administration and Human Resources on revision of the job descriptions, salary structure, and the detailed assessment of the budgetary impact.

Due to the fact that we have had fairly short notice on this matter and because it is such a critical position for overall department operations, we are requesting the ability to take action as soon as reasonably practical to begin the promotional and proposed restructuring process. The Police and Fire Commission's (PFC) role is relative to the promotional/hiring process so we will also be requesting that they authorize a promotional process to enable us to fill two Assistant Chief positions. At this time I request that the Council approve the creation of the Assistant Chief positions so that the promotional/hiring process may move forward.
