



Schneider Markets Inc. is in the process of purchasing the Piggly Wiggly grocery store from Victor Hinkes. The license the applicants seek would continue to allow this store location to sell carryout packages of fermented malt beverages and also a small selection of intoxicating liquors. This location has been a licensed establishment for a number of years with no concerns noted by law enforcement.

The license the applicant is seeking would allow this store location to sell carryout packages of fermented malt beverages and also a small selection of intoxicating liquors. This location has been a licensed establishment in the past with no concerns noted by law enforcement.

Mr. Moses advised that this location will be affiliated as a Clark brand gas station. They will carry a large selection of premium coffees and espressos at their Coffee bar, as well as sandwiches, pizza, a salad bar and other foods.

Assistant Chief Klein discussed department expectations of licensed agents with the Mr. Moses. Mr. Moses has many years of experience as a business owner and being a license holder in the City of Fond du Lac. He is currently the owner of Philly's on Fourth Street, and has owned/operated convenience stores in the City previously. The applicant was advised that this matter will go in front of the Alcohol Licensing Committee on April 29, 2013, at 4 p.m. and that he should be in attendance.

Background checks were conducted on the applicant, both in-house and NCIC/CIB which indicated no prior criminal history. There is nothing in the applicant's background that would preclude him from obtaining the requested license. The Police Department has no objections to the approval of the proposed license and recommends approval.





**Re:** Resolution Regarding CTH V Interchange

We have prepared a resolution for the May 8 Council meeting which would encourage the State of Wisconsin to budget for the construction of the proposed US 151 / CTH V interchange.

With the recent release of the Environmental Evaluation report for the US 151 Bypass, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT) has completed the steps necessary prior to land acquisition and construction of proposed improvements. The highest priority improvement locally is the US 151 / CTH V (County Highway V) interchange.

Construction of the proposed interchange at US 151 and CTH V would provide for much better access to and from US 151 for residents and visitors, and would also facilitate the future development of lands south of US 151. The frontage road on the north side of the highway, along with the realignment of Reinhardt Road south of the highway, will provide for good access in both directions.

A series of improvements is planned for US 151 over the next twenty to thirty years. In the near term, the CTH V interchange and the CTH T overpass are very high priorities. In the long term – twenty years or more in the future – a new system interchange could be constructed at US 41 and 151, as well as a new service interchange on US 41 further to the south. At that time, it would be necessary to close Camelot Drive and overpass Martin Road. Other local street improvements would be put in place to provide good local access in those areas.

The City Council is already on record as favoring the construction of an interchange at CTH V. Copies of resolutions to that effect are attached. Former members of Council, along with city and county staff, law enforcement, other elected officials and property owners participated in a series of “stakeholder” meetings with DOT that took place between 2008 and 2011.




**Re:** Resolution Authorizing Extension of Option

J.F. Ahern has requested an extension to our agreement to option 50 acres in the Fox Ridge Business Park for a period of one year, with the ability to extend the option by another year. The agreement would provide that the company may purchase the land at a price of \$1.1 million at any point during the option period. The 50 acre parcel is shown on the attached map. J.F. Ahern will pay \$10,000 per year for the option.

The company wishes to extend the option in order to secure the site while it considers the potential need for expanded facilities in the Fond du Lac area. See the attached letter for details. A right-of-first-refusal provision remains as well, so that if another buyer emerges the City may sell the parcel to that other buyer. During the two years that the option agreement has been in place, no such opportunity has occurred.

The selling price of \$1.1 million for 50 acres works out to \$22,000 per acre, which is below our standard price of \$32,000 per acre. Given the large size of the parcel, however, the City faces less investment in public improvements (street, sewer, etc.) to serve the property, which saves money. These avoided costs make the price per acre comparable to the standard price in terms of net proceeds.

J.F. Ahern has been a responsible corporate citizen and employer in Fond du Lac for over 130 years. Service to such a company is one of the primary reasons we build business parks. I recommend approval of the extended agreement.


