**Autumn Fisher** (Wastewater), who serves as our Operations Research Coordinator at the wastewater treatment plant, received a Laboratory Analyst Excellence Award in May from the Water Environment Foundation. Notably, she was nominated by four different groups for this award, and was selected from all the wastewater labs in a three-state area. She has been selected to represent the Central States Water Environment Association in a competition in New Orleans this September. Autumn will be part of an Operations Challenge team for our three-state region. During the competition, teams will be confronted with emergency situations, giving them both an opportunity to be recognized for past accomplishments, but to also test themselves with other top performers.



**Rick Reehl** (Electrical) has completed installing LED lighting at Fire Stations 1 & 2. This provides better light and is expected to pay for itself in around three years. 
## National Police Week
