

CITY COUNCIL VACANCY

The City Council of Fond du Lac is now accepting applications through May 10th to fill a vacancy on the Council. This vacancy is to fill the balance of the remaining term of Former Council President Jim Sabel. The term for this office would end in April 2014.

Timeline. Application acceptance closes on May 10th. The Council will hold interviews during the week of May 12th. At the regular City Council meeting on May 22nd, the Council will vote to determine who they wish to select.

Form of Government. The City of Fond du Lac is a City Manager/Council form of government organized under Chapter 64 of the Wisconsin State Code. Chapter 64 describes the powers of the Council.

64.07. Powers of council; its organization; quorum; meetings.

(1) The council shall possess and exercise all legislative and general ordinance powers imposed and conferred by general law or special charter upon the mayor and common council and the various boards and commissions not inconsistent with ss. 64.01 to 64.15, and in force in such city at the time of its reorganization and such additional powers as are hereinafter imposed and conferred, but such council shall not have the power to enact special executive or administrative orders, it being the intent of ss. 64.01 to 64.15 to separate the legislative and executive powers of city government.

Qualifications. An applicant must be a resident of the City of Fond du Lac, be 18 years old and cannot be convicted of a misdemeanor involving a violation of the public trust or a felony.

Position and Duties. The City Council serves as the legislative arm of City government. It decides policy matters. The Council enacts ordinances, resolutions and motions; approves and amends the budget, levies taxes; approves claims made against the City and grants licenses issued by the City. The Council meetings are regularly scheduled for the second and fourth Wednesdays of the month. The meetings have been starting at 7pm, but will begin starting at 6pm beginning in June of 2013. There are other special meetings from time to time, especially during the budget process in the late summer and fall. Council members are expected to attend all meetings unless excused.
