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City of Fond du Lac - Weekly Construction Update

The City of Fond du Lac is providing a weekly update on construction projects located within the corporate boundary. Motorists are advised to use caution and remain alert when driving through any work zone. Drivers are also encouraged to visit the City of Fond du Lac web site at <http://www.fdl.wi.gov> and view a map of the 2012 construction projects which may aid drivers in planning an alternate route.

Ninth Street from Military Rd to Fond du Lac River

Schedule: April 9, 2012 to early August 2012

Description: The project includes reconstruction of the sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, street, and lighting.

April 16 to April 20: The utility contractor will continue water main installation. The contractor has progressed to Morris Street will continue to work toward the west.

Traffic Impacts: Ninth Street is closed to through traffic. Morris Street at Ninth Street is closed to all traffic. Northbound or southbound traffic will not be permitted in or out of the project at the Morris Street and Ninth Street intersection. It is illegal to drive past a "ROAD CLOSED" sign or to move any construction barricades. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past "ROAD CLOSED – LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY" signs. Parking is not permitted on the street during working hours.

Morris Street from Ninth St to Central Ave

Schedule: April 9, 2012 to early August 2012

Description: The project includes reconstruction of the water main, storm sewer and street.

April 16 to April 20: The utility contractor will begin water main installation at the intersection with Ninth Street and work to the north toward Central Avenue. This work will be completed in conjunction with the work on Ninth Street.

Traffic Impacts: Morris Street at Ninth Street is closed to all traffic. Northbound or southbound traffic will not be permitted onto Ninth Street at the Morris Street intersection. It is illegal to drive past a "ROAD CLOSED" sign or to move any construction barricades. Residents, business owners and customers may access properties past "ROAD CLOSED – LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY" signs. Parking is not permitted on the street during working hours.

Ellis Street from Ninth St to Boyd St

Schedule: Early May 2012 to early October 2012

Description: The project includes reconstruction of the sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, street, and lighting. The street will be widened to the 32-foot City standard.

April 16 to April 20: The electrical subcontractor will bore electrical conduit along the west side of Ellis Street from Boyd Street to Eleventh Street Monday morning. The City's subcontractor may begin tree removal and relocation.

Traffic Impacts: Ellis Street remains open to traffic. Traffic may be temporarily restricted while crews are at work.

Liberty Street from Ninth St to Eleventh St

Schedule: Early June 2012 to early October 2012

Description: The project includes reconstruction of the sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, street, and lighting.

April 16 to April 20: No work this week.

Traffic Impacts: Ninth Street at Liberty Street is closed to through traffic. Liberty Street remains open to traffic. Residents should access Liberty Street from Eleventh Street.

Eleventh Street from Ann St to Cedar St

Schedule: Early June 2012 to early October 2012

Description: The project includes reconstruction of the sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, street, and lighting.

April 16 to April 20: No work this week.

Traffic Impacts: Eleventh Street remains open to traffic.
