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### City of Fond du Lac - Weekly Construction Update

The City of Fond du Lac is providing a weekly update on construction projects located within the corporate boundary. Motorists are advised to use caution and remain alert when driving through any work zone. Drivers are also encouraged to visit the City of Fond du Lac web site at <http://www.fdl.wi.gov> and view a map of the 2012 construction projects which may aid drivers in planning an alternate route.

#### Ninth Street from Military Road to Fond du Lac River

**Schedule:** April 9, 2012 to early August 2012

**Description:** The project includes reconstruction of the sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, street, and lighting.

**May 28 to June 1:** The utility contractor has completed installation of sanitary sewer laterals and water services. Midweek the contractor will begin installation of storm sewer main. The contractor will begin at the Morris Street intersection and work to the east. A second crew with the utility contractor may arrive at the end of the week to also install storm sewer main. The second crew for the contractor may be working between Morris Street and the Fond du Lac River.

**Traffic Impacts:** Ninth Street is closed to through traffic. Morris Street at Ninth Street is closed to all traffic. Northbound or southbound traffic will not be permitted in or out of the project at the Morris Street and Ninth Street intersection. It is illegal to drive past a "ROAD CLOSED" sign or to move any construction barricades. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past "ROAD CLOSED – LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY" signs. Parking is not permitted on the street during working hours.

#### Morris Street from Ninth Street to Central Avenue

**Schedule:** April 9, 2012 to early August 2012

**Description:** The project includes reconstruction of the water main, storm sewer and street.

**May 28 to June 1:** The utility contractor will be installing water services early in the week. Once the services are completed the contractor will begin installation of storm sewer main.

**Traffic Impacts:** Morris Street at Ninth Street is closed to all traffic. Northbound or southbound traffic will not be permitted onto Ninth Street at the Morris Street intersection. It is illegal to drive past a "ROAD CLOSED" sign or to move any construction barricades. Residents, business owners and customers may access properties past "ROAD CLOSED – LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY" signs. Parking is not permitted on the street during working hours.

#### Ellis Street from Ninth Street to Boyd Street

**Schedule:** May 14, 2012 to early October 2012

**Description:** The project includes reconstruction of the sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, street, and lighting. The street will be widened to the 32-foot City standard.

**May 28 to June 1:** The utility contractor has completed sanitary sewer installation. The contractor will begin installation of water main at the intersection with Boyd Street and work toward the north.

**Traffic Impacts:** Ellis Street is closed to through traffic. It is illegal to drive past a "ROAD CLOSED" sign or to move any construction barricades. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past "ROAD CLOSED – LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY" signs. Parking is not permitted on the street during working hours.

**Liberty Street from Ninth Street to Eleventh Street**

**Schedule:** Early June 2012 to early October 2012

**Description:** The project includes reconstruction of the sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, street, and lighting.

**May 28 to June 1:** Alliant Energy's subcontractor has finished installing new gas main along the east side of the street. The subcontractor may begin installing new gas services late in the week. The City's subcontractor will begin tree removal.

**Traffic Impacts:** Ninth Street at Liberty Street is closed to through traffic. Liberty Street remains open to traffic. Traffic may be temporarily restricted while crews are at work. Residents should access Liberty Street from Eleventh Street.

**Eleventh Street from Ann Street to Cedar Street**

**Schedule:** Early June 2012 to early October 2012

**Description:** The project includes reconstruction of the sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, street, and lighting.

**May 28 to June 1:** Alliant Energy's subcontractor will begin installing new gas main along the north side of the street. The subcontractor will be working between Walker Street and Cedar Street. The subcontractor may begin installing new gas services late in the week. The City's subcontractor may complete tree removal near Ann Street late in the week.

**Traffic Impacts:** Eleventh Street remains open to traffic. Traffic may be temporarily restricted while crews are at work.

**Street Maintenance**

**Schedule:** End of May to early August 2012

**Description:** Street maintenance work will be done on several streets during the next few weeks. Traffic will be maintained, however, there will be lane closures and no parking signs posted while work is being done. The work on each street will take about two days. The first day, wide cracks in the street will be routed, cleaned, and sealed. The following week, a different operation will fill potholes and level more significant bumps. The list of streets includes:

**Western Avenue** from Seymour Avenue to Evans Drive

**Western Avenue** West 650 feet from Evans Drive

**Hickory Street** from Scott Street to Johnson Avenue

**Arndt Street** from Seymour Street to Peters Avenue

**Security Drive** from Pioneer Road to Peters Avenue

**Mequon Avenue** from Maona Avenue to CTH V

**Scott Street** from Roosevelt Street to Luco Road/National Avenue

**21st Street** from Main Street to Park Avenue

**Morningside Drive** from 4th Street to McDermott Creek, 1600 feet west of Prairie Road

"No Parking" signs will be placed in the terrace as work begins or the afternoon before work begins where parked cars may be in the way of the work early the next morning.
