NTOA Basic Crisis Negotiations Course



The Fond du Lac Police Department is co-hosting the NTOA's Basic Crisis Negotiations course (Course # 20151970), which will be a 5-day training at Fond du Lac Public High School, from July 13th - 17th, 2015.

This 5-day negotiations training course is designed for individuals recently assigned to Crisis Negotiations Teams. Topics to be covered include a historical and contemporary perspective of CNT, team structure and management, the Tactical Operations Center (TOC) Concept, types of crisis situations, hostage-taker profiles, tactical force options, negotiations processes, communication techniques, and negotiator stress. New negotiators will gain the skills necessary for resolving a variety of incidents.
