**Arrest Warrant Issued in Infant Death**

On July 21, 2015 a nationwide arrest warrant was issued for 29-year-old Daniel Antwon Griffin, Male/Black with a date of birth of 03-09-1986 for 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Reckless Homicide and 2-counts of Child Abuse Intentionally Causing Great Bodily Harm in connection with the death of a 14-month-old male infant and the serious injuries of the 14-month-olds twin brother. Griffin is believed to be in the Chicago and Calumet City Illinois area.

### **Fond du Lac Police Make Arrest in Infant Death**

During the afternoon hours of July 15, 2015, Fond du Lac Police Department Investigators arrested a 23-year-old woman from Calumet City Illinois in connection with the death of a 14-month-old child that occurred at an apartment in the 800 block of Martin Ave. on July 7, 2015. The woman was taken into custody at the City of Fond du Lac Police Department by Investigators and is currently being held in the Fond du Lac County Jail on preliminary charges of Child Neglect Causing Death and Child Neglect Causing Great Bodily Harm. Additional arrests are anticipated.

Fond du Lac Police Investigators have been assisted in their investigation of this incident by the Fond du Lac County Department of Social Services, Milwaukee and Chicago Police Departments. The investigation remains active and additional information will be released with the issuance of the criminal complaints.

**Police Investigate the Death of Infant**

On July 7, 2015 at approximately 1:56 p.m., Fond du Lac Police and Fire/Rescue personnel responded to a report of a baby that was pulseless and non-breathing at an apartment in the 800 block of Martin Ave. Police and Fire Department paramedics arrived on the scene and immediately began providing life saving measures to the infant. The 14-month- old male infant was transported to St. Agnes Hospital where the child was pronounced dead.

The investigation into the circumstances that lead up to the death of the infant is active and ongoing at this time. No other details are being released at this time pending the outcome of the investigation.
