Infant Homicide Fugitive Arrested

The Fond du Lac Police Department in cooperation with the United States Marshal's Office is announcing that Daniel Antwon Griffin was arrested on August 4, 2015 in Dallas Texas. Fond du Lac Police Detectives worked with members of the U. S. Marshal's Fugitive Task Force in locating Griffin. Griffin was wanted on a Nationwide Felony Warrant for 1st Degree Reckless Homicide and 2-counts of Child Abuse Causing Great Bodily Harm in the death and abuse of twin 14-month old boys. Griffin was taken into custody by the Marshal's without incident at a Dallas area motel.

Chief William Lamb stated, "We are glad that Mr. Griffin is now in custody and can be held accountable for the horrific crimes he is accused of. I want to thank Detectives Matt Bobo and Nick Hahn as well our partners with the U. S. Marshal's Office, especially their Milwaukee, Chicago and Dallas Field Offices for all their hard work on this case."

Kevin Carr, United States Marshal for the Eastern District of Wisconsin stated, "we are pleased to have been able for the Marshals Service to assist the Fond Du Lac Police Department in apprehending this fugitive who is accused of committing this unthinkable violent act against innocent babies".

Griffin is currently being held in the Dallas County Jail awaiting extradition and transport back to Wisconsin.
