The City of Fond du Lac Police Department is announcing another major arrest operation targeting drug dealers in the City of Fond du Lac that was launched this morning at approximately 9:30 a.m. Today's arrest operation is the result of ongoing joint investigations by officers and investigators of the City of Fond du Lac Police Department and Lake Winnebago Area Metropolitan Enforcement Group - Drug Unit.

A task force of approximately 20 officers deployed in arrest teams to locate and arrest 17 individuals for which felony arrest warrants have been issued for their involvement in drug trafficking in the Fond du Lac area. During today's arrest operation, 9 of the 17 individuals listed with arrest warrants were taken into custody by the task force. While serving the warrants, an additional subject outside the 17 named in the arrest warrants was taken into custody on drug charges.

Eight of the suspects taken into custody during today's operation were arrested for Manufacturing/ Delivery of Cocaine, while the other two were arrested for Manufacturing/Delivery of Heroin.

City of Fond du Lac Police Chief Bill Lamb stated, "The Fond du Lac Police Department will continue to aggressively investigate and arrest those individuals who choose to deal illegal drugs in our community. We have often stated that illegal drug dealing is not only a Law Enforcement concern, but a concern for the entire community. The recent Heroin summit held at Marian University is a prime example of the Community coming together to be better informed on the dangers of Heroin and other drugs. The support that we have received and continue to receive in the way of tips and intelligence information from the public has greatly assisted us with investigating and arresting drug dealers. We continue to urge those citizens who suspect illegal drug activity taking place in their neighborhoods to contact our Department at 906-5555."

We would like to take this opportunity to publicly thank our law enforcement partners that have played an integral role in assisting us with today's arrest operations - in particular, the Lake Winnebago Area Metropolitan Enforcement Group - Drug Unit and the Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Department.

As of 4 p.m., we hold active arrest warrants for the following individuals that were not located during today's operation. Anyone with information on these individuals is asked to call the City of Fond du Lac Police Department at 920-906-5555.
