### SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION BULLETIN

The Fond du Lac Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 (Act 440) and 301.46 (2)(e) (Act 5), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a juvenile sex offender's release when, at the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agencies. His previous criminal history places him in a classification level which reflects the potential to re-offend.

This sex offender has served the sentence imposed on him by the courts. THIS PERSON IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities, but it was not until passage of Act 440 (which mandates sex offender registration) that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notification. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.

**Jacob Schwendimann** was recently released from prison after being convicted on 04-28-10 for failure to provide information to the Sex Offender registry as required by law. In 2009 Schwendimann was also convicted of Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor in Ohio. The victim was a cooperative teenage female that he met on the internet.

Schwendimann has a number of juvenile adjudications out of Washington County that require registration:

1. 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Sexual Assault of a Child in 2007 when he was 16 years old. The victim was a 14-year-old cooperative male peer.
2. 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Sexual Assault of a Child in 2006 when he was 15 years old. This victim was a 14-year-old cooperative male peer.
3. 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Sexual Assault of a Child in 2005 when he was 14 years old. The victim was a 12-year-old cooperative male peer.

Jacob Schwendimann is currently living at 197 N. Main St., in the City of Fond du Lac. He is no longer under any type of probation, parole or extended supervision. **Jacob Schwendimann is required to comply with the Sex Offender Registry until 2023.**
