SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION BULLETIN

The Fond du Lac Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 440), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offenders release when, at the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agencies. Further, his/her previous criminal history places the offender in a classification level which reflects the potential to re-offend.

This sex offender has served the sentence imposed on him/her by the courts and has advised officials that he/she will be living in the location below. THIS PERSON IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of Act 440 (which mandates sex offender registration) that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notification. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.

The Fond du Lac Police Department is available to help you set up Neighborhood Watches and to provide you with useful information on personal safety. The City of Fond du Lac Police Department has been notified by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections that registered Sex Offender, **Jermaine Akins** recently relocated to Fond du Lac from the State of Ohio. On January 24, 2000, Akins was convicted in the State of Ohio for Attempted Abduction with Sexual Motivation. He was sentenced to prison for 6 months concurrent with a probation violation. Akins's victim was a 10-year-old female in which he grabbed her by the arm and led her into a bedroom and began to unzip his pants before the victim was able to flee. In addition, Akins has an extensive arrest record for offenses including Felonious Assault, Domestic Violence, Attempted Murder and multiple cases of Failure to Register.

Special conditions:

Akins has reached mandatory release and, therefore, is not currently under Department of Corrections supervision. However, he is required to register with the Sex Offender Registration Program until March 8, 2014.

Akins will be living at 161 West Follett Street.
