SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION BULLETIN

The Fond du Lac Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 440), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offenders release when, at the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agencies. Further, his/her previous criminal history places the offender in a classification level which reflects the potential to re-offend.

This sex offender has served the sentence imposed on him/her by the courts and has advised officials that he/she will be living in the location below. THIS PERSON IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of Act 440 (which mandates sex offender registration) that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notification. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.

The Fond du Lac Police Department is available to help you set up Neighborhood Watches and to provide you with useful information on personal safety. Dennis R. Thiel is being released from Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center. Thiel will be released on August 10, 2012 after being under secure supervision since 1993 for 1st Degree Sexual Assault of a Child. In 1987 Thiel was convicted of sexually assaulting a 9-year-old female who was known to him. While on probation in 1993, Thiel was convicted of sexually assaulting an 11-year-old female who was known to him. Thiel completed his prison term in 1997 and remained confined under Chapter 980 Civil Commitment. Thiel was recently discharged from supervision from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services as well as Corrections. Thiel will be living at 75 North Hickory Street in the City of Fond du Lac.

Special conditions of Dennis R. Thiel's release:

- 1) Face-to-face contact with law enforcement as required, lifetime registration with Wisconsin Sex Offender Registration Program.
- 2) Lifetime GPS registration and monitoring.

Dennis R. Thiel will be living at 75 N Hickory Street in the City of Fond du Lac when he is released on August 10, 2012.
