City of Fond du Lac - Weekly Construction Update

The City of Fond du Lac is providing a weekly update on construction projects located within the corporate boundary. The Weekly Construction Updates and Construction Map are posted on the City's Website at www.fdl.wi.gov.
All anticipated construction activities are weather dependent.

2nd Street from Vincent Street to DeNeveu Creek

Schedule: May 16th through October

Description: The project includes gas main and service relocations, reconstruction of sanitary sewer and laterals, storm sewer and laterals, water main and laterals, roadway, sidewalk and approaches, street lighting and restoration/landscaping.

September 12 to September 16: Restoration contractor will be back to finish topsoil and seeding.

Traffic Impacts: 2nd Street is closed to through traffic. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past "ROAD CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC" signs. It is illegal to drive past a "ROAD CLOSED" sign or to move any construction barricades. Parking is not permitted on the street within the construction zone during working hours.

N. Butler Street from Russell Street to Portage Street

Schedule: July 7th through October

Description: The project includes gas main and service relocations, reconstruction of sanitary sewer and laterals, storm sewer and laterals, water main and laterals, roadway, sidewalk and approaches, street lighting and restoration/landscaping.

September 12 to September 16: No work is anticipated this week.

Traffic Impacts: N. Butler is closed to through traffic. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past "ROAD CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC" signs. It is illegal to drive past a "ROAD CLOSED" sign or to move any construction barricades. Parking is not permitted on the street within the construction zone during working hours.

S. Butler Street from Forest Avenue to W. Division Street

Schedule: July 11th through October

Description: The project includes gas main and service relocations, reconstruction of sanitary sewer and laterals, storm sewer and laterals, water main and laterals, roadway, sidewalk and approaches, street lighting and restoration/landscaping.

September 12 to September 16: Pending weather, road excavation could begin following progress at Bell St.

Traffic Impacts: S. Butler is closed to through traffic. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past "ROAD CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC" signs. It is illegal to drive past a "ROAD CLOSED" sign or to move any construction barricades. Parking is not permitted on the street within the construction zone during working hours.

S. Bell Street from Bragg Street to Forest Avenue

Schedule: July 11th through October

Description: The project includes gas main and service relocations, reconstruction of sanitary sewer and laterals, storm sewer and laterals, water main and laterals, roadway, sidewalk and approaches, street lighting and restoration/landscaping.

September 12 to September 16: Road excavation to begin at beginning of week.



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Grove Street from Hillcrest Lane to Seymour Street

Schedule: June 6th through October

Description: The project includes gas main and service relocations, reconstruction of sanitary sewer and laterals, storm sewer and laterals, water main and laterals, roadway, sidewalk and approaches, street lighting and restoration/landscaping.

September 12 to September 16: Restoration contractor will be back to finish placing topsoil and seed.

Traffic Impacts: Grove Street is closed to through traffic. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past “ROAD CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC” signs. It is illegal to drive past a “ROAD CLOSED” sign or to move any construction barricades. Parking is not permitted on the street within the construction zone during working hours.

14th Street Reconstruction

Schedule: May 31 through October

Description: The project includes gas main and service relocations, reconstruction of sanitary sewer and laterals, storm sewer and laterals, water main and laterals, roadway, sidewalk and approaches, street lighting and restoration/landscaping.

September 12 to September 16: Contractor will continue with storm sewer main and lateral installation. The pipe-bursting contractor will continue installing storm laterals on private property. Road excavation will begin next week between Park Ave and Vine St

Traffic Impacts: 14th Street is closed to through traffic. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past “ROAD CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC” signs. It is illegal to drive past a “ROAD CLOSED” sign or to move any construction barricades. Parking is not permitted on the street within the construction zone during working hours.

Military Road from Western Avenue to Superior Street – WI DOT Northeast Region

Schedule: April 11-October 2022

Description: The reconstruction of S Military Rd includes reconstruction of the street and utilities, addition of bike lane and construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Military Road and 9th Street.

September 12 to September 16: The concrete crew will complete the placement of the roadway gravel base. String line for concrete paving will be installed on Monday followed by trimming of the gravel along the east side, northbound lanes of the project. Access to driveways along the east side of the roadway will be restricted during these operations. Concrete paving is scheduled for the week of September 19 (east side) and 26th (west side), weather pending.

Traffic Impacts: Military Road remains closed to through traffic. Residents, business owners, and customers may access properties past “ROAD CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC” signs. The intersection of Military Road and 9th Street remains closed to traffic.



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WIS 23 Expansion – Urban Section – WI DOT Northeast Region

Location/limits: WIS 23 and various intersecting local roads between US 151 and Seven Hills Road

Schedule: April 11, 2021 to fall of 2022

Description of work: This work is part of the WIS 23 4-lane, on-alignment expansion project in Sheboygan and Fond du Lac counties.

September 12 to September 16: The contractor anticipates working on the following items:

- Complete the remaining storm sewer installation work on WIS 23 westbound
- Place curb and gutter at rural intersections on WIS 23 eastbound
- Begin placing asphalt shoulders along WIS 23 eastbound
- Begin paving the new asphalt on WIS 23 eastbound
- Begin curb and gutter placement on the County K interchange
- Begin prepping for curb and gutter installation on the new Whispering Springs access road
- Begin construction of the new right turn lane on the Highway 151 northbound off ramp to WIS 23.
- Continue construction of the retaining wall between Hilltop and County UU.

Traffic impacts:

- County K north at WIS 23 – Closed
- County UU (South of WIS 23) – Closed
- County UU (North of WIS 23) – Closed
- Beginning the week of September 12: the contractor will begin construction on the new right turn lane for the Highway 151 northbound off ramp to WIS 23. During construction of the new turn lane, roadway widths will be reduced. Anticipate delays while using the ramp during construction.
- Beginning the week of September 12: the contractor will begin construction on the new right turn lane for the Highway 151 northbound off ramp to WIS 23. During construction of the new turn lane, the WIS 23 eastbound right lane will be closed from County Lane to the east. Anticipate delays while using WIS 23 eastbound during construction.
