The CDC updated their COVID guidance based on COVID-19 Community Levels.

People may choose to mask at any time. People with symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should wear a mask.

Because the City of Fond du Lac work locations are not in areas identified as high community levels, employees are not required to wear a mask or remain 6 feet apart from others while working at this time regardless of vaccination status. We will monitor updates on community transmission rates and update these guidelines as necessary.

As a reminder, while the City of Fond du Lac strongly encourages employees to get vaccinated against the coronavirus, we do not require any employee to be vaccinated.

Employees may continue to follow masking and physical distancing protocols if they so choose, and all employees are expected to be supportive of their co-workers' choices.

As state and federal authorities release new health and safety guidance and requirements; The City will continue to review and update our coronavirus-related policies and procedures as warranted and inform you of any changes.
