The Fond du Lac Recreation Department will be hiring Lifeguards to work at the Outdoor Pools for the summer. Lifeguards have the opportunity of working full-time, job sharing, or working as a sub. All Lifeguards must be certified through the American Red Cross; completion of the course certifies Lifeguards for 2 years. **Starting pay for a full-time Lifeguards is \$12.50/hour with opportunities for end of season bonuses and a FREE Fond du Lac YMCA membership.**

Lifeguard Training Class

Pre-requisites for the class:

- Students must be 15 years old to work as a lifeguard
- Swim 300 yards using front crawl and/or breaststroke in a continuous swim with rhythmic breathing and stroke, no touching the bottom of the pool or resting at any time.
- Tread water for two minutes using only leg motion (hands will be placed under opposite armpits).
- Swim 20 yards, go down 7 – 9 feet, retrieve a brick, maintain two hands on the brick while swimming 20 yards to the starting point and getting out of the water without using a ladder.
Time Limit: 1 minute 40 seconds
