# SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION BULLETIN


The Fond du Lac Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 440), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offenders release when, at the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agencies. Further, his/her previous criminal history places the offender in a classification level which reflects the <u>potential</u> to re-offend.

This sex offender <u>has served</u> the sentence imposed on him/her by the courts and has advised officials that he/she will be living in the location below. <u>THIS</u> <u>PERSON IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME</u>. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of Act 440 (which mandates sex offender registration) that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notification. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.

The Fond du Lac Police Department is available to help you set up Neighborhood Watches and to provide you with useful information on personal safety. The Fond du Lac Police Department has been notified by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections on a change of address for **Christopher R. Hensler**. Hensler was released back into the community May of 2017 after serving additional jail time for rule violations. Hensler was originally released from prison and back into the community on July 28, 2015 after serving time in prison for 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Sexual Assault of a Child. Hensler's victims were a 13-year-old and 14-year-old female acquaintances. In addition, Hensler was previously convicted in the State of Michigan for Criminal Sexual Conduct- 2<sup>ND</sup> Degree (Personal Injury).

## Special conditions of Christopher R. Hensler's supervised release:

- 1) No contact with victim, no unsupervised contact with minors, no presence in taverns, bars, or liquor stores, and no use of alcohol or illegal drugs.
- 2) Comply with all rules of high risk sex offender supervision and cooperate with lifetime GPS monitoring.
- 3) Face-to-face contact with law enforcement as required, lifetime registration with Wisconsin Sex Offender Registration Program.
