The Fond du Lac Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Accreditation Group (WILEAG), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session on November 13, 2019 at 5:00pm. The session will be conducted in Conference Room A (front lobby access) located at the Fond du Lac Police Department 126 N. Main Street.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by call 920-204-2749 (a non-recorded line) on November 13, 2019 between the hours of 2:00pm and 4:00pm. Comments will be taken by the WILEAG Assessment Team assigned to conduct this assessment.

Telephone comments as well as appearances at the public information session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with WILEAG's standards.
