### **City of Fond du Lac Police Investigate Vehicle Thefts**

**Fond du Lac, WI:** City of Fond du Lac Police (FDLPD) are urging community members to lock and secure doors and windows on unattended vehicles. Remember when securing your vehicle, it's also important to remove valuable items.

In a two-day period (May 9, 2022 into the morning hours of May 10, 2022) FDLPD started to field complaints of thefts from parked vehicles on the west side near Sabish Middle School and also on the east side near SSM Health (St. Agnes Hospital). Initial complaints suggest approximately 15 – 20 vehicles were involved. It is too early to say if the east side and west side locations are connected or not.

FDLPD Officers and Detectives are actively investigating these crimes related to theft from a motor vehicle and criminal damage to property.

Chief Aaron Goldstein said, “This increase of crime is uncharacteristic of our community. We have resources devoted to investigate these crimes and to hold those responsible for these crimes accountable.”
