City of Fond du Lac Police Investigate Two Early Morning Incidents

Fond du Lac, WI: On Monday, June 27, 2022 the City of Fond du Lac Police Department (FDLPD) responded to two early morning hour incidents. At 1:06 a.m. the FDLPD responded to a 9-1-1 call in the 300 block of Forest Avenue for a report of an individual shot multiple times inside a residence. Initial information led to a large police response which included the deployment of an armored vehicle, drone, robot, and K-9 Unit. FDLPD contacted the alleged victim, a 30-year-old male Fond du Lac resident and eventually determined there was no shooting. The male admitted to drug use. The City of Fond du Lac Fire/Rescue transported the male to St. Agnes (SSM Health) Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

At 2:22 a.m. FDLPD, Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Deputies, and the City of Fond du Lac Fire/Rescue responded to a 9-1-1 call for assistance in the 300 block of W. Division Street. Theda Star medical helicopter was requested for a 32-year-old male Fond du Lac resident with an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound. Theda Star landed in the intersection of W. Division Street and Lincoln Avenue and eventually transported the male to a hospital with what are believed to be life threatening injuries. The investigation into this incident is still at the preliminary stages and remains under active investigation.

No further details or information are being released at this time.
