Homicide Investigation – Media Release from August 20, 2022

Fond du Lac, WI: On Saturday, August 20, 2022 at approximately 7:20am, City of Fond du Lac Police Officers and the City of Fond du Lac Fire/Rescue Department responded to a 9-1-1 call for assistance in the 200 block of Marquette Street for an individual laying on the ground. Upon arrival, FDLPD Officers located a 40-year-old male from the Fond du Lac area who was found deceased from an apparent gunshot wound.

FDLPD Detectives responded to the scene. The investigation into the circumstances that led up to the death of the 40-year-old male is active and ongoing at this time. The Fond du Lac Medical Examiner's Office will perform an autopsy on the victim to determine the exact cause and manner of death. The identity of the deceased is not being released at this time, pending family notification(s).

Detectives are working to identify possible suspects. At this time, no suspect(s) have been taken into custody. FDLPD Officers and Detectives continue to canvass the area this morning.
