



City of Fond du Lac Police Department Injury Accidents September 2, 2022



On September 2, 2022 at approximately 9:16 p.m., the Fond du Lac Police Department (FDLPD) and Fond du Lac Fire/Rescue responded to the area of Scott Street and Mill Street for a report of an individual with a scooter who was struck by a vehicle.

The investigation into this accident is at the preliminary stages. Initial information provided leads Officers to believe that the individual with the scooter was originally attempting to cross Scott Street northbound by Mill Street. A 53-year-old Fond du Lac resident was operating a vehicle travelling westbound on Scott Street. The individual with the scooter was struck by the vehicle as they attempted to cross the street. The individual was initially transported by Fond du Lac Fire/Rescue to SSM Health (St. Agnes) and later transported by Fond du Lac Fire/Rescue to Froedtert Hospital-Milwaukee with life threatening injuries.

We are still attempting to positively identify the individual with the scooter. Anyone with information regarding this accident is asked to call the Fond du Lac Dispatch Center at 920-906-5555.

An additional accident was discovered at 10:34 p.m., when a Fond du Lac Police Department (FDLPD) Officer happened to find an unconscious subject down on the terrace at the intersection of Fond du Lac Avenue and County Road V. The 51-year-old Fond du Lac resident did not have a pulse and was not breathing. The Officer performed CPR until the individual's pulse returned and Fond du Lac Fire/Rescue arrived on scene.

The investigation into this accident is also at the preliminary stages. Initial information provided leads Officers to believe that the moped hit the curb and ejected the individual onto the terrace. Fond du Lac Fire/Rescue provided care until Flight for Life landed at the scene and flighted the man to Froedtert Hospital-Milwaukee with life threatening injuries.

No additional details are available at this time for both accidents.
