The Municipal Service Center would like to inform residents the new hours of operation for the City's Bulky Waste Drop-Off Site.

Effective December 1, 2018 the **Department of Public Works Bulky Waste Drop Off Site, located at 530 Doty St.** begins our Winter operating hours as follows:

### **Hours of Operation:**

Hours (December 1 – March 31)

<b>Monday</b>	<b>9:00 to 3:15</b>
Tuesday	Closed
<b>Wednesday</b>	<b>9:00 to 3:15</b>
Thursday	Closed
<b>Friday</b>	<b>9:00 to 3:15</b>
Saturday	Closed

### **Fee Structure:**

- There is a charge \$20 for a single use of the site.
- We offer a ten use pass, or punch card, which is transferrable, **for \$175.**
- Fees for Freon items and tires are still in effect and will be charged in addition to single use fees.
- Cash and checks are accepted at the site using an envelope system.
- Credit and debit cards are accepted at the Municipal Service Center office.
- Single use passes and punch cards are available at the City Clerk's office and the Municipal Service Center.
- Contractors are not eligible to use the site.
- Construction debris is not accepted at the site.
- Single use and ten use passes require proof of residency.
- Only metal items for recycling may be dropped off for free.
- Cardboard and paper for recycling require a daily fee.

### **Attendant:**

The site has an attendant on duty all hours for which the facility of open for business.

### **Curb Side Bulky Waste Collection:**

The cost for bulky collection at the curb begins at \$40 minimum and anything over one cubic yard will be charged an additional \$40 per yard. This is in addition to any fees for freon items and tires. Please call 920-322-3544 for further information on bulky waste collection.

**Yard Waste Site**

There is no charge to dump yard waste, brush and garden material in the yard waste mulch bin, open 24 hours a day every day. The use of this site is limited to City residents.

**Hazardous Waste**

Earlier this year, the household hazardous waste site was closed. However, the City continues to accept waste oil from City residents at no charge. The oil drop off is located inside the bulky waste yard, and is available when the site is open. The attendant will direct users to the site.
