The City of Fond du Lac Senior Center, the City of Fond du Lac Police Department and Drug Free Communities of Fond du Lac County are partnering to sponsor this drug take back event. Bring your expired or no longer needed

medications to the Senior Center for disposal. To dispose of your medications at the event or drug drop boxes, remove pills from their original container and place in a sealed ziplock style bag. Empty bottles may be disposed of in your home recycling. Liquid medications should remain in their original containers, 3oz or less. If you miss the event you may drop your medications off at any of thirteen the permanent drug drop locations throughout Fond du Lac County that are open year round.
