CARDIO DRUMMING

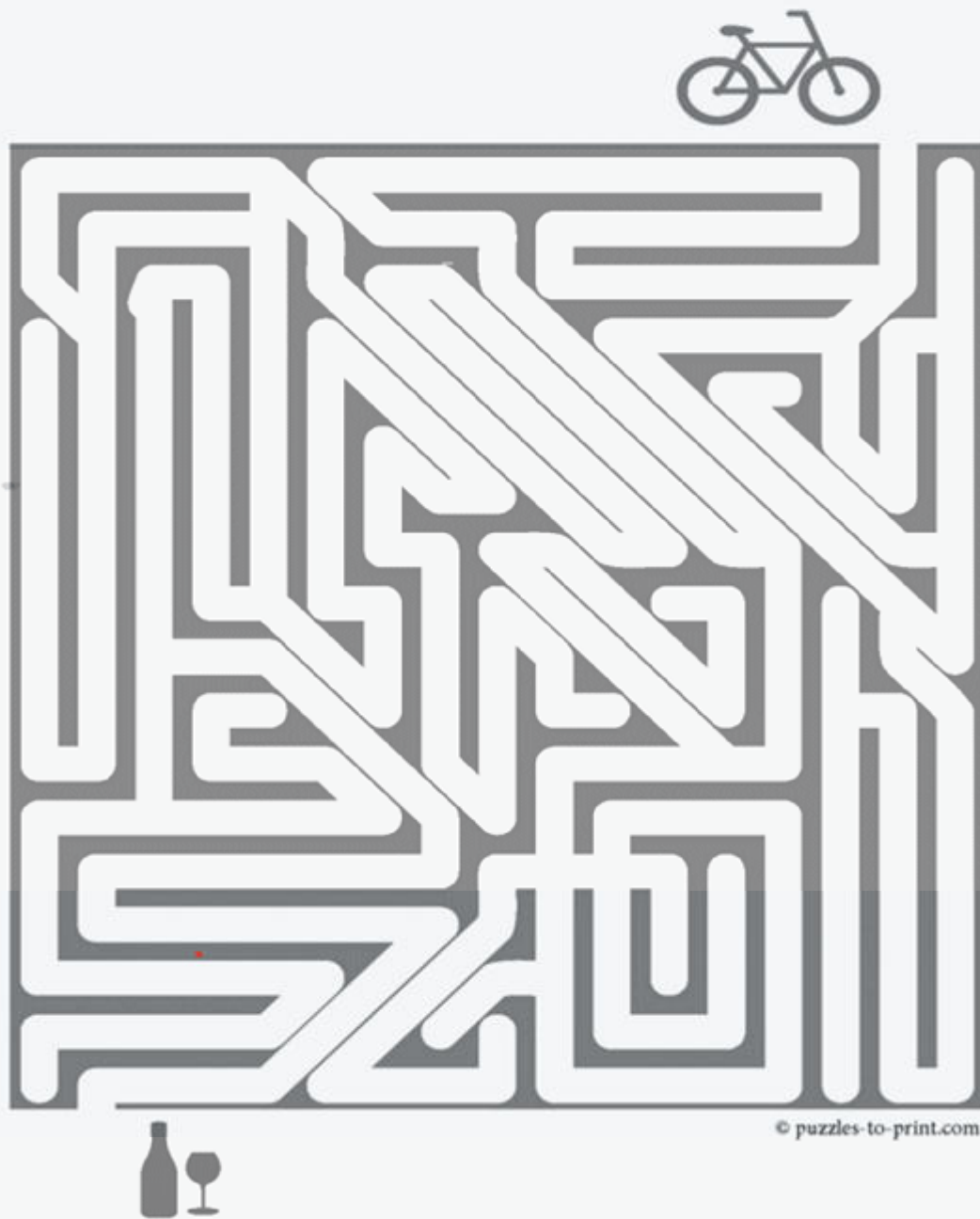
What is it? A drumming workout!
