## CATHY'S CORNER

"Normal": the usual, average, or typical state or condition. "New Normal": a current situation, social custom, etc., that is different from what has been experienced or done before but is expected to become usual or typical; a state to which an economy, society, etc. settles following a crisis, when this differs from the situation that prevailed prior to the start of the crisis.

We have had several versions of "normal" over the last 15 months - the January 2020 "open for business" normal when we were just hearing rumblings of this new virus called Covid-19, the late February/early March 2020 "pre-shutdown normal" when things were changing rapidly and decisions were being made on a day-by-day or hour-by-hour basis, the mid-March 2020 "building closed shift to virtual programming" normal, and for the last couple of months, the "safely, slowly reopening normal".

Several times in the last weeks, someone has asked when the Center is going to "get back to normal". I completely understand that many people want the January 2020 version of "normal". It would be nice (and much easier in a lot of ways!) if we could just pick up where we left off and pretend that the last 15 months never happened, but unfortunately, that isn't how life works. I truly do appreciate the sentiment that people share when they want things to go back to "normal" - our Center is a special place and people want that experience back.

I was on a Zoom call last week where someone shared that their organization's philosophy wasn't that they were getting "back to normal", but they were going to be "Back to Better". That's what we are trying to do here, too. We have had time to look at the things that were working at our Center, and the things that needed a refresh. What does this mean?

- We have taken this opportunity to completely rebuild our program and activity schedule to assure that we have space and time for new opportunities as well as accommodating a wide variety of past activities.
- This new schedule was created with a priority on having programs that are open to all.
- We will not ask about vaccination status and assume (based on Fond du Lac County data) that we will be serving a combination of people that have and have not been vaccinated.
- We expect all Center participants to be **respectful** of each others choices.
- We want to make sure that everyone that walks in feels welcome, comfortable, and safe.
- We will be cognizant of how many people are in a program or activity at a given time, and will limit numbers if necessary to keep tables and chairs spaced comfortably apart.
- Reservations will still be required as this helps us be prepared to best serve participants in attendance.
- As we have done in the last few months, we will continue to add programs each month being mindful of the items mentioned above.

We hope you join us as we embrace the 2021 version of normal.
