CATHY'S CORNER

Many years ago, I was a "Call Staff" instructor for Moraine Park Technical College. At that time, a "Call Staff" instructor was a person who was certified to teach because they had a combination of education and work experience in the subject area. One of my favorite classes to teach was called "Introduction to Computers for Older Adults", and I really enjoyed it because they didn't identify what "older" meant, so I had students that ranged in age from 40 to 80.

I didn't think about it then, but now I realize how important the word "older" was in welcoming people of any age to that class.

We feel the same way about our Center. Our focus is on creating programs for people 50+ and at one point were serving people from 50 to 103 years of age! What is interesting are the comments we receive from people we encounter - everything from the 80-year-old saying that they aren't "old enough to go to a Senior Center", to the 60-year-old who said her friends tease her about taking classes at the "Senior Center".

Across the country, there is pushback against the word "senior". The same thing happened about twenty years ago with the word "elderly". For many people, these words seem to promote a stereotype and generate a negative perception of aging and the gift of longevity. Many industries that serve people in the 50+ demographic have started using the word "older" to be more inclusive and to more accurately represent the people being served.

When it comes right down to it, there are an awful lot of people who don't think of themselves as a "Senior Citizen". One of the lighter comments I have seen in regards to this topic, was asking why do we call people 50+ "Senior Citizens" if we aren't calling people under 50 years old "Junior Citizens". Food for thought!

With all that being said, if you have been to The Center in the last few weeks, or if you noticed the cover of this newsletter, our new sign has been installed! While we will always be the "City of Fond du Lac Senior Center" and the Friends will be the "Friends of the Fond du Lac Senior Center", we thought the time was right for our sign to be more welcoming. We feel that The Center - A Place For Active Older Adults reflects what happens here - we are a place where active older adults come to learn, play, work on their health and wellness, connect to resources, volunteer, and make friends. Thank you for making our Center what it is!

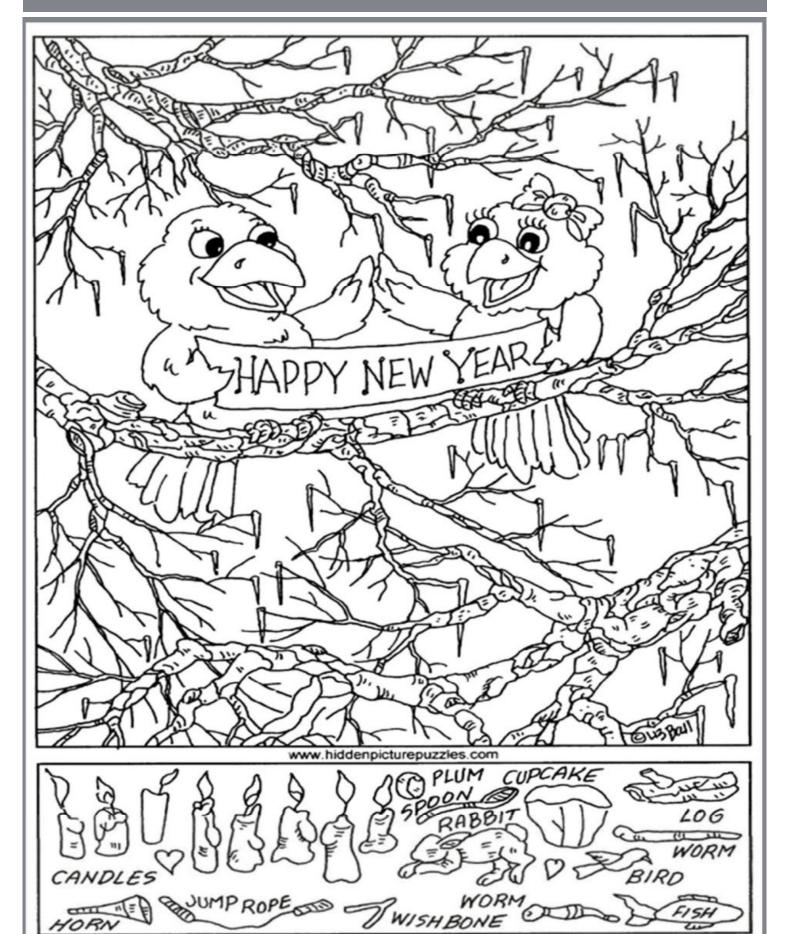
