

If you currently have a 5 gallon per flush toilet and replace it with a 1.28 GPF model, based on 10 flushes per day, the savings is 13,578 gallons per year. Using current water and sewer rates it would mean an annual reduction of \$80.46 on the water portion of your bill and \$70.38 on the sewer portion, for a total annual savings of approximately \$150.84. Of course this will vary depending on the number of residents in the household and water use habits.

Save Money. The City of Fond du Lac Water Utility is offering a rebate of up to \$100 when you upgrade your old toilet using 3.5 gallons per flush (GPF) or higher, to a new high-efficiency model. A toilet using 3.5 GPF or more accounts for roughly 26% of a home's indoor water use. One of the easiest ways to lower your toilet's water use by nearly 62% is to install a high-efficiency toilet (HET), which uses on average 1.3 GPF, or less. Although HETs use less water, they remove waste effectively and perform well.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- * Participants must be residential customers of the City of Fond du Lac Water Utility, and installation address must be in the service area of the utility.
- * Toilets must be purchased after June 1, 2015. This offer is not retroactive.
- * 1 rebate, for 1 toilet, per household or apartment unit.
- * Qualified properties include single-family homes, condominiums, and apartment buildings of 4 units or less.

Eligible Toilet Replacement

- * Standard 1.6 GPF toilets do not qualify
- * Must replace a working toilet flushing 3.5 GPF or higher. See diagram to determine tank volume.
- * Toilets installed after 1994 do not qualify. The date of manufacture is often stamped into the porcelain on the underside of the tank lid. Toilets made after 1994 were generally efficient, those made in the 1980's used 3.5 GPF and older models used much more water.

- * Eligible replacement toilets must be WaterSense labled models listed on the EPA website at:
 - www.epa.gov/WaterSense/products/toilets.html
- * All rebates are subject to availability of funds on a first-come, firstserved basis.
- * Applications must be submitted within 30 days of purchase.
- * Rebates are for replacement of existing larger capacity toilets not new construction.

How to Get a Rebate

- * Purchase and install any qualifying model.
- * Complete and submit an application with an original, unaltered, dated sales receipt listing the model number. Contractor's receipt must include applicant's name, and/or installation address.
- * Applicant agrees that the Fond du Lac Water Utility reserves the right to inspect the installation before or after the rebate is given.

To find a qualifying model, look for the WaterSense label, ask your toilet retailer, visit EPA website listed above, or call the Fond du Lac Water Utility at 920.322.3680.



Rebate checks of up to \$100 (not to exceed actual purchase price, excluding sales tax and installation charges) will be sent to the customer's address or credited to their account, after the application is processed. Please allow four to six weeks to process.



Application Checklist

- Did you check that your old toilet meets eligibility rules?
- Did you enclose an original paid receipt showing applicant's name and/or installation address?
- □ Is the toilet model number printed and legible on the receipt? (UPC and SKU #'s accepted)
- □ Is the EXACT MODEL NUMBER of the toilet you purchased on the qualifying WaterSense list of HETs?
- □ Have you completely filled out and signed the application form?
- Did you include your water service account number on the application?

Did you install your HET and mail rebate application within 30 days of purchase?
