



Drinking Water in the United States is some of the safest water in the world since tap water is subject to testing more frequently than bottled water.

Fond du Lac Water Utility tests their water 3 times a week from each treatment plant for proper levels of hydrous manganese oxide (HMO), which removes radium from the water and chlorine used to disinfect and remove any bacteria if present. Also Monthly water samples are taken from 50 different sites throughout the city to test for bacteria & chlorine levels. Wells are checked monthly to monitor surrounding water table levels, pH & temperatures of water. Inorganic Compounds, Radioactivity Contaminants & Disinfection Byproducts are tested at treatment plants and at sites in the distribution system.



Save Money and Drink Tap Water

Most Adults can consume between 96 oz. – 125 oz. of water per day. Over a year period that could add up to around 2,400 bottles of water per individual. Now if you only drank bottled water you could be paying up to \$250 per year. If you consumed that same amount provided by your local water utility that cost would decrease to just \$3.60 for the year. Now multiple this by the number of individuals in your home.....and the cost savings is tremendous!
